This on-going project for American Airlines consists of the demolition of Terminals 8 & 9 and the construction of a new 36-gate terminal complex.

In order to maintain American's continuing operation, construction has been skillfully planned and phased to avoid disruption to the flight schedule.

Encompassing over 1,400,000 square feet, the 3-story terminal will feature a departures hall; the size of which is equivalent to five football fields; with exposed steel trusses, a 70 foot high curtain wall system and terrazzo floors.

In addition to the departures hall, the project also involves construction of (3) concourses with a 400 foot tunnel connecting Concourses B and C. Other features include food courts, retail concession areas, Admirals Clubs, FIS facilities, baggage claim areas, and holdrooms.

Site work includes installation of over four million square feet of new aircraft paving, underground utilities to service the complex, as well as a hydrant fueling system.
