

CARGO FACILITY

This project involved the renovation of Cargo Building 67 for Delta Air Lines at JFK. The scope of work included removal and replacement of the existing roof including installation of a perimeter railing and exterior lighting on the roof top.

Additional work included removal and replacement of thirty nine (39) overhead dock doors at the inbound and outbound docks which involved removal of all steel channel frames and masonry walls, installation of an overhead radiant heat system, new dock bumpers and docklevers including new pits. Work was completed in 7 phases in order to keep the facility operational.

The final phase of this project involved construction of a 3,000 square foot walk-in cooling room located in the high bay warehouse including electrical service and sprinklers.
